Peggy Carlson moved and Bruce Mohs seconded approval. The motion passed unanimously.

Bruce H reminded members who missed the August meeting to look over the meeting minutes carefully, as important matters were discussed. Elizabeth also reminded members that the August Exec committee minutes were shared electronically.

Financial Reports/Treasurer's Report

A. August Fundraising Report

Bruce reviewed the report, as distributed. We continue to receive donations for the Homeless Fund. Donations for the Adopt A Classroom campaign are currently at \$16,000, but more are expected. In total, the fundraising this year, to date, is \$214,298.

B. Treasurer's Report

Bruce reviewed the August Profit and Loss Statement noting that it remains close to last year's in expenditures, far ahead in public support..

Cindy Horner moved and Joe Mullen seconded approval of financial reports as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

2017-18 Activities Grants

The amounts for granting have been determined and are as follows:

- A. \$37,834 for 2017-18
- B. \$21.500 for Fall 2017
- C. \$14,334 for Spring 2018

<u>Immersion Program Celebration:</u>

Elizabeth explained the Thursday, September 21, 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. program at Lake George. This marks ten years of success with the program, and this is significant for all such programs in Minnesota. The event will feature performances, some carnival like activities for families and some booth displays that include LEAF. Volunteers are needed to be at the table – please wear LEAF polo shirts – and enjoy.

Night of the Stars

Bruce reminded the members that will this event is an excellent PR and friend-raising endeavor, the NOTS program has not proven to be lucrative as a fundraiser. The overhead costs are significant, and much of the ticket revenue is passed through directly to the schools. It is also very time/staff intensive. The greatest source of revenue is sponsorships, and the online auction is a distant second.

Discussion resulted in a general consensus that this event remains important for visibility. Ideas to save money with less expensive advertising, and a potential change from auction to more raffles were suggested. Other suggestions included:

- Use high school auditoriums rather that the Paramount because of the cost of that facility.
- Include a 50/50 raffle
- Raise adult ticket price from \$16 to \$18
- Include more of a direct ask at the event.

Bruce indicated that the committee is still seeking an auction chair, and that changes may be a consideration once that position is filled. He also asked for suggestions for additional sponsors. It was suggested that we not conduct an auction if no one was interested in chairing it.
