Call to Order and Additions to the agenda (President Mohs) Meeting called to order at 4:02 by Bruce M.

Bruce H. shared the Feb. 2022 fundraising report. \$21,587.00 was brought in for grants. The majority of that was for the new Schnettler legacy fund. 2022 has started off very well for LEAF. The stock market has been difficult during the month of February though. Bruce H. shared the profit and loss statement. The net income for 2022 so far is \$26,256.58. Bruce H. also shared the balance sheet. Our total liabilities and equity are \$2,203,318.00. Rob V. asked a clarifying question about the Schnettler legacy fund. It will be a scholarship for either an Apollo or Tech student with the remaining money each year to be given to support math, science, or EL programing.

Motion made by Chad R. to approve the treasurer's report. Abdi D. seconded the motion. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

Grants Update (Peggy Carlson & Bob Feigh)

- Presentation of Grant Recommendations from Grants Committee for Spring Cycle.
- Action Requested: Approval of Grant Recommendations for Spring Grant Cycle
- Grant process for 21-22 School Year

Motion was made by Charlie E. to approve the grant recommendations from the grant committee for the spring cycle. Greta seconded the motion. Bob F. described how the funding for each grant was determined. Everyone voted in favor to approve the grant recommendations for the spring cycle.

Bruce H. shared that LEAF's restricted legacy fund grants total \$24,351.00. Peggy explained how we usually subtract restricted grants from the amount available for activity grants. We will change this next fall. We will subtract the restricted grants from the money available for activity and academic funds in the fall and then the remaining money will be divided in half. Peggy and Bruce H. are revising the grant application.

Fall academic round dates: Opens on May 1st and will close on Sept. 30th. The grants meeting for academic grants will be on Oct. 18th.

Fall activity grant round dates: Opens on May 1st and will close on Sept. 20th. Grant meeting for activities on Oct. 4th Academic and activity grants will be approved at the October 24th board meeting.

Additions to the agenda:

Letter of inquiry was sent to the Initiative Foundation for \$102,000.00 for PAKRAT and PAKCAT. The grant was written to purchase new, diverse books for the PAKRAT school year program, to expand PAKRAT and PAKCAT to Somali daycare settings, to expand the summer book bus to Sauk Rapids and Sartell along with funds to purchase more books for the bus and to expand PAKCAT through 1st grade. They have \$700,000.00 available to give in grants.

Homeless fund fundraiser: We are down to \$8,000.00 in our homeless fund. We would like to do a spring fundraiser to boost the fund. We have \$25,000.00 so far in challenge funds. This includes two \$10,000.00 donations and one \$5,000.00 donation. We would like to raise \$50,000.00. LEAF will mail out flyers to people who have donated in the past. The Earth Day Run organization is paying the organizations for the volunteers they provide. LEAF said they would provide 40 volunteers for Saturday, April 16th. Rebecca Groenewald and Jen Loch are working on volunteers. They have 25 volunteers so far and need 15 more. Peggy is asking for board members who are willing to volunteer. Let Peggy know if you are interested. LEAF will receive \$1,700.00 for the homeless fund for providing volunteers.
