Bruce shared the September fundraising report. September was a sparse month. Apollo and Tech's golf tournaments are not on the report yet. Our Adopt a Classroom donations were the highest they have ever been. LEAF's total assets are \$2,064,533.16. Tim B. shared the profit and loss statement. Our management and general expenses are a little higher than last year because our printing costs are up, and Bruce H.'s salary increased slightly. We have \$440,528.33 in unrealized loss because of the tough stock market. Tim B. also shared the balance sheet.

Lori J. made a motion to approve the financial reports. Steve S. seconded the motion. Everyone voted to approve the financial reports.

LEAF Grant Committee Recommendations (Peggy Carlson and Bob Feigh)

- A. Peggy and Bob presented the academic and activities grant recommendations for Cycle I 2022-23
- B. Action Requested: Approval of grant allocations

Peggy C. made a motion to approve the grant allocations. Charlie E. seconded the motion. Bob Feigh walked us through the academic and activity grant recommendations. The academic grants funded totaled \$17,482.00. After discussion, everyone voted to approve the academic grant recommendations.

There was \$23,644.00 available for activity grants. There was \$19,064.00 in requests for activity grants. All the activity grants were fully funded. The remaining \$4,582.00 was added to the activity's participation fund. After discussion, everyone voted to approve the activity grant recommendations.

CMCF 3rd Quarter Reports

The CMCF sends out quarterly reports about 20 days after the end of the quarter. The reports are divided into sections as follows:

- 1. Contributions to the Fund in the quarter
- 2. Interest & Dividends
- 3. Realized Gains/Losses

- 4. Unrealized Gains/Losses
- 5. Grant given from the Fund
- 6. Other fund expenses
- 7. Total Fund Balance at end of the Quarter

The CMCF reports indicated that LEAF had a balance of \$1,147,232.48 in the Activities Fund and \$704,319.78 in the Academic Fund as of September 30, 2022. Bruce H. shared the total investment returns for the past five years. We have a total investment loss of \$496,140.79 as of September 30th. Tim B. found an error. The document should read \$6,425.07 instead of -\$60,346.67 on the quarter 3 Activities fund. Bruce H. will get it fixed.

Last Thursday was the first meeting of the strategic planning committee. The group discussed LEAF's mission and vision. The group decided the current mission statement sounded good.
