Bruce H. walked us through the financial report. February was not the best month for fundraising. Our endowed funds at the end of February were \$2,116,378.55. Our net income for the year so far is \$960.40. Night of the Stars had a net profit of \$2,103.63 for the Music Matters fund. \$3,760.00 is given back to schools through ticket grants. It has never been a big fundraising event. It's more of LEAF PR event, music program showcase, and chance for students to show their talents to a larger audience. Our attendance was down considerably this year. Our expenses were at the same level as when we had the show at the Paramount. The Night of the Stars will be back at the Paramount next year.

Lori made a motion to transfer the net profit of \$2,103.63 from the Night of the Stars fundraiser account to the Music Matters fund. Steve S. seconded the motion. Everyone voted in favor.

A motion was made by Rob V. to approve the financial report. The motion was seconded by Chad R. Everyone voted in favor.

5% of our endowed funds are available for grants each year. LEAF has \$99,210.00 available for grants in 2023. Peggy C. displayed the recommendations from the grants committee for the spring grants. The committee approved the total amount of \$23,606.00 available for grants. Abdi asked for clarification on the CPR/First Aid certification grant. Rob V. asked why the electronic judge system for diving for Apollo was not approved. Peggy explained that it was not recommended by the athletic director because of the small pool size.

A motion was made by Chad R. to approve the grants committee recommendations. The motion was seconded by Abdi D. Everyone voted in favor.

<u>Music Matters</u> fund along with the Al Dahlgreen/Once Upon a Child Fund will support a total of \$5,475,000.00 in grants in 2023. That means there is \$5,475.00 available to spend in the 2023 school year. The Music Matters committee met and recommended that the money be used for:

- 1. Transportation and expenses for high school music programs to visit and interact with elementary school students.
- 2. Transportation and expenses for middle school music programs to visit the appropriate high school music program and to interact with high school music students in those programs.

A motion was made by Bruce M. to approve the music matters committee's recommendation for the \$5,475.00. The motion was seconded by Lori J. Chad R. had several questions. What is the policy if a music teacher wants to submit a grant? Do they have to go through the Music Matters fund? Chad would like to see a policy written about how the Music Matters funds are spent. Bruce H. said music teachers can apply for either an academic or activities grant based on the need. Bruce H. and Peggy clarified that the Music Matters committee will decide each year how the funds will be used. The Music Matters committee decided to use the money for 2023 for the two recommendations listed above. Diane M. stated that she thought Chad had a good point about making a policy because there is overlap with this fund and the activity and academic funds.

Bruce M rescinded his motion. Lori J. also rescinded her second. Chad asked if we could delay our vote until the May board meeting. Justin S. asked for clarification on which music teachers were part of the committee. Diane M. stated that all music teachers in District 742 were invited and several attended. They were going to report to Kara who is the Fine Arts Coordinator. Chad R. asked to table this until the next board meeting, and stated he is willing to work on a policy with anyone else who would like to help. Diane added she agreed with Chad and said maybe we need to review who is on the music matters committee and add this to the policy.

Chad made a motion to table this discussion so we can write a policy about who is on the committee and how the money is granted. Steve S. seconded the motion. Everyone voted in favor.
