Since they are so close, the executive board voted in favor of setting up a legacy fund in her name. Bruce H. will be doing the eulogy at her service on Sunday.

The PAKRAT book bus had a very successful summer. It ran for 7 weeks with 18 stops a week. We checked out 5,918 books to 2.081 students.

• Apollo/Tech Golf Scrambles

LEAF serves as the fiscal host for the golf scrambles. Both were very successful and well attended. The Tech scramble brought in close to \$30,000.00. Bruce H. didn't have a total for the Apollo scramble yet. 50% of the profits go directly to activities at each school and 50% goes into legacy funds for the two schools.

Fundraising Report: Peter Matter Legacy memorial scholarship fund was missing from the original fundraising report. The amount is \$25,000.00. \$122,613.77 is our total funds raised so far this year. The stock market is doing much better this year, so our funds are growing again.

Profit and Lost Statement: Apollo and Tech golf tournament funds will not be reflected until September. Our management and general expenditures are up some because of the management fees we are paying to Bergan/KDV.

Balance Sheet: LEAF's total assets are \$2,128,857.88.

Reconciliation Report: One of the things we would like to address with Bergan/KDV is removing the old checks that go back almost 10 years.

Andrea Preppernau made a motion to approve the financial reports and Chad Roggeman seconded it. Everyone voted in favor.

Tim Beck is staying with us through the transition process and then Rob Voshell has agreed to take over as treasurer for LEAF.

Our fall grant applications are open right now. The fall activities grant applications close on Friday, Sept. 22^{nd} and the academics applications close on Oct. 5^{th} . The board will vote on the grant committee's recommendations at our board meeting on Oct. 30^{th} .

Participation fund is used to help students get sports physicals, equipment and sometimes Metro bus passes so they are able to participate in activities. LEAF has an agreement with CVS for \$49.00 physicals for District 742 students. Bruce H. and Peggy Carlson are working with CentraCare to see if we could work together to provide physicals for students.
