 - The meeting was called to order at 4:02 by Diane M.

 - d. Kicks for the Homeless Student Services Fund
 Sharon is working on this event and hopes to host this event the first
 week of September. She would also like to set up a planning
 committee for this event.
- 5. Changing the Name of the "Homeless Student Services Fund"
 The school district calls it transitional student services. Natalie would like to change it to protect the student's dignity. 803 students have been helped in District 742 this school year through the transitional services department. The district predicts it will be over 1,000 students next school year. We discussed how we should change the name of our fund to protect the dignity of our students and families but make sure donors know what they are donating to.

Suggestions included housing stability partnership, family bridging services, and the benevolence fund. Everyone agreed that we need to be careful selecting a name for the fund so our donors still know what they are donating to. We decided that Natalie would email the PR committee the above suggestions on Wednesday. They would come up with final suggestions which would go to the vote of the full board. This timeline will need to have a quick turn around because we would like to have the new name ready for Bruce's retirement party. Bruce would like people to donate to this fund instead of giving him a retirement gift.
