

F12 – Policies - New Ventures – Funds/Fundraising and Designated Flow-Through Funds

From time-to-time the LEAF board of directors shall establish designated flow-through funds for specific purposes and conduct fundraising efforts in support of those designated flow-through funds. A fee of up to 2% of the gift may be required; however, as of 2021 LEAF has not charged a fee for service of any designated flow-through gifts.

When considering a new Fund or Fundraising effort, the following process will be used:

- A. Executive Committee will determine if a new venture should be considered
- B. If yes, the Executive Director will call the *New Ventures Review Committee* together.
- C. The NVR Committee will be a standing committee and will consist of one member from the Executive Committee, one member from the Budget & Finance Committee, two members from the Grants Committee, and two at-large members.
- D. The NVR committee will review the initiative and make recommendation to the full Board.
- E. The LEAF board of directors will decide if a new fund or fundraising effort will be initiated

Current LEAF Flow-Through Funds – 2021

PAKRAT

- This is a reading literacy and parent involvement program in support of young learners in grades Preschool - 3rd grade in District 742.

PAKCAT

- This is a math literacy and parent involvement program in support of young learners in the District 742 preschool program.

Homeless Student Services

- This fund supports District 742 students and their families who are experiencing homelessness.

Adopt-A-Classroom

- \$250 gifts are solicited to adopt a classroom in a District 742 schools. The funds are used to purchase classroom supplies.

School Lunch Fund

- Funds are donated to support students/families who do not necessarily qualify for free/reduced lunch, but who need assistance in paying their school lunch cost.

Activities Participation

- This fund helps pay for costs associated with a student's participation in the activities program when those costs make participation difficult or impossible for the students. Transportation, physicals and equipment are eligible expenses to be paid through a LEAF grant.

Special Flow-Through Funds

- A donor can make a gift in support of any District 742 program and LEAF will be the conduit for the gift.
