- 5. Jim Dwyer Guest
 - Developing Planned Giving

Jim talked to us about planned giving. Fundraising is fun, but still work! The checks for planned giving are usually significantly larger than regular donations. A good salesman makes 3 to 4 calls a day. He recommends putting the LEAF name out as often as possible when people are doing estate planning, for example: "Remember the kids of District 742 when planning your estate." Put it in your newsletter every time with a slogan like, "Leave a legacy to LEAF!" or "Leave LEAF in your will." Go to Legacy.com and use one of the plans already created, print it out and send it out. Who should you market to? What are your needs, what do you want to do, and what would you like to see happen with your donation to our organization? Be direct and ask at events like Night of the Stars, Cafe Renaissance and others. One on one personal sales work the best, but sending out a form for planned giving also works.

Bruce H. shared the proposed budget for 2023. There are very few changes from the 2022 year. We will increase the Office Equipment from \$200.00 to \$700.00 to factor in the cost of a new laptop for Lori to use. Peggy thought we should increase the postage budget under the management and general portion of the budget. We should also increase the postage budget under fundraisers. We agreed to increase the postage budget to \$4,500.00 in fundraisers and \$1000.00 in the management and general part of the budget. \$241,382.00 is projected for program expenses for the 2023 year. \$68,792.00 is our projected final net income for 2023. Peggy made a motion to approve the budget for 2023 and Lori seconded.

LEAF received an anonymous gift of \$4,000.00. Our policy states for all unrestricted gifts accepted by LEAF will be allocated equally between the student activities fund and the academic fund. Bruce would like to bring a suggestion board for this gift that \$1,000.00 goes to the activities fund, \$1,000.00 to the academic fund, \$1,000.00 to the music matters fund, \$500.00 to PAKRAT and \$500.00 to PAKCAT. Bruce sent a letter of acceptance stating what the money will be used for. We would like to change this suggestion to \$1,500.00 to academic fund, \$1,500.00 to activities fund, \$500.00 to PAKRAT and \$500.00 to PAKRAT. This will be the final proposal that will go to the full board for approval.
